

Community Bowling Challenge 2019

Date: 9th & 10th March 2019

Venue: Orchid Bowl @ SAFRA Punggol

Rules & Regulations, Prize List, Schedule and Entry Form

1. Eligibility

The Community Bowling Challenge 2019 is a tournament organised by Orchid Bowl and supported by Punggol Coast CSC which open to all Singapore Citizens. The tournament shall be played in accordance to the Rules and Regulations of World Bowling.

2. Entry Fee & Venue

The Entry Fee will be **\$100/- per team (team of 4)**.

The Qualifying & Masters Final venue for this tournament are as follows:

QUALIFYING WILL BE HELD AT:

MASTERS FINAL WILL BE HELD AT:

Date: 17th March 2019

Time: 9am (Roll Off)

3. Format of Play

This tournament uses ONLY Mixed Team event. Top 20 teams will proceed to the Masters Final (based on total pinfalls of individual team achieve)

3.1 Team:

Shall consist of 4 bowlers in the registered team bowling 3 games each. Combined pinfalls of these 4 bowlers shall determine the total pinfalls for the event.

A team must consist of at least 4 bowlers, inclusive of 1 female bowler OR 1 male bowler as the team composition criteria.

4. Masters Final

They will bowl a total of 3 games, scratch. The team with the highest total pinfalls after the Masters Final shall be crowned Champion.

5. Squad Time

The Organiser reserves the right to reallocate squad times, and there shall not be any additional squad.

6. Tie-Breaking Procedure

In the event of a tie, the team high game shall be used to determine the winner but if it is still a tie after which, the next team high game shall be used until the tie break.

7. Tardy Bowlers

In the event of tardy bowlers, the bowler may be permitted to join in at the frame of the game that the opponent bowler is bowling, in the respective lane. The clock in the host venue shall be the official timepiece.

8. Check In Procedure – Qualifying / Masters Final

All Finalists are to check-in AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE the scheduled time. The clock in the bowling center will be the official timepiece.

9. Refund

9.1. No refund shall be made after an entry or registration is being accepted.

9.2 A participant or team who fail to show up upon and/or is late for the schedule squad shall be disqualified from participating in the squad and entry fee shall be forfeited.

10. Interrupted Game

The Organiser may authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the starting lanes would delay the normal progress of the game.

11. Bowling on Wrong Lane

When the lead-off bowler bowls on the wrong lane and the error is discovered before another bowler has bowled, a dead ball shall be declared and the bowler will be required to re-bowl on the correct lane. When more than one bowler has bowled on the wrong lane, the game shall be completed without adjustments and the next game shall be started on the correctly scheduled lane.

12. Slow Bowling

Slow bowling is not allowed and bowlers must bowl when it is their turn to do so.

13. Dress Code

Bowlers are required to be properly and appropriately dressed for bowling. If the Organiser is of the opinion that a bowler is not properly dressed, he/she may not be permitted to bowl.

14. Prizes & Awards

Prizes in the form of vouchers/products etc, will be awarded to the winners of the tournament.

There shall be no perfect game award. Bowling Center House Awards do not apply throughout the Tournament.

15. Protest

Protest involving eligibility or general playing rules must be submitted in writing to the Organiser within 24 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred, or before prize presentation.

16. Errors

Errors in scoring or in calculation must be corrected by a responsible tournament official immediately, upon discovery. The Technical Committee shall decide questionable errors. The time limit for registering protests on scoring errors shall be one hour from the end of the squad for each day of the tournament. Each protest under this rule must be specific in it and shall not be construed to cover a previous or similar violation.

17. Special Notes

17.1) Bowlers are requested to refrain themselves from swearing on the lanes.

17.2) Bowlers shall restrict themselves to their respective lanes and exercise consideration for all participants.

17.3) Bowlers wearing soft rubber soles on their non-sliding foot may be barred from further bowling, subject to the scrutiny of the Organiser. NO POWDER IS ALLOWED ON THE BOWLER'S AREA.

17.4) The Organiser reserves the right to accept or reject any entry they deem fit.

17.5) Any matters arising and not covered in these Tournament Rules shall be decided by The Organiser or its committee whose decision shall be final.
